What do we need?

What's the problem?

Most high school and university students in Cambodia graduate with poor English proficiency, particularly those from public schools and rural areas. Despite being taught in the national curriculum, English is frequently taught in a limited, antiquated manner that places a greater emphasis on grammar than on communication. There are few opportunities for students to practice speaking, listening, or writing in real settings, and many teachers lack formal English language training.



Consequently, students encounter significant obstacles when trying to obtain scholarships, university courses, internships, and employment opportunities that necessitate proficiency in the English language. Their inability to fully participate in online learning environments, scholarly research, and global knowledge is another consequence of their poor English proficiency, which further divides young people in urban and rural areas, as well as those who can afford private education from those who cannot.

What do we do?

Through engaging lessons, group discussions, and real-world situations, JWOC provides hands-on, student-centered English instruction that emphasizes communication skills in speaking, listening, writing, and reading. We provide structured lessons and conversation labs with qualified instructors to up to 25 students each month. Students who complete the program will have the skills necessary to succeed in university, apply for scholarships, and pursue employment opportunities that require fluency in English.
