

Laptops for JWOC Operations

Period: 2025-2026

What do we need?

JWOC is seeking support to purchase 5 new laptops to replace outdated and non-functional devices currently used by our team. These laptops are essential tools for delivering our programs effectively, managing operations, and maintaining communication with our students, partners, and donors. An estimated \$550-\$650 per laptop, so a total \$2,750-\$3,250 is needed to ensure that staff have reliable equipment to continue delivering high-quality services to youth across our programs. Any contribution makes a difference.

What's the problem?



JWOC implements 2 core programs: the Better Futures program for high school and post-high school students and the University Scholarship program. Our mission is to empower low-income Cambodian youth to succeed in education, employment, and community engagement.

While most donor funding is allocated directly to program costs, operational needs such as equipment replacement often remain

unfunded. Many staff members currently rely on secondhand or outdated laptops, several of which are no longer functional. 5 laptops have recently become unusable, directly impacting our ability to deliver training, track progress, and support over 2,000 students effectively.

What do we do?

The JWOC team uses laptops daily to plan, monitor, and report on student progress, design training materials, communicate with stakeholders, and ensure the smooth delivery of services. Replacing these broken laptops will allow our staff to work efficiently and maintain the high standard of support our students deserve. With upgraded equipment, we can ensure that all operations—from student support to donor reporting—remain uninterrupted and impactful.
